Lists allow developers to group a set of related items together. There are three types of list

- Unordered List
- Ordered List
- Description List

Unordered List:

An unordered list tag begins with a `` and ends with `` tag. Each Item within the `` tag starts with `` and ends with a closing tag ``.

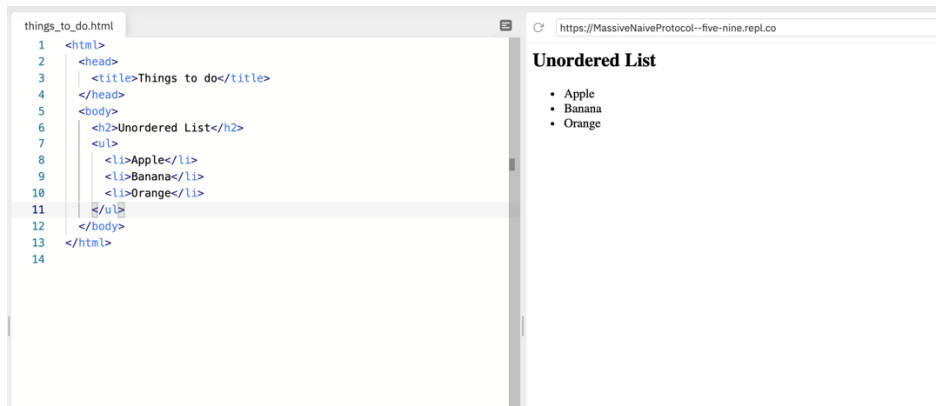


Figure 1: Unordered list

Ordered List:

An Ordered list tag begins with `` and ends with `` tag. Each item within the `` tags starts with a `` and ends with a closing tag ``

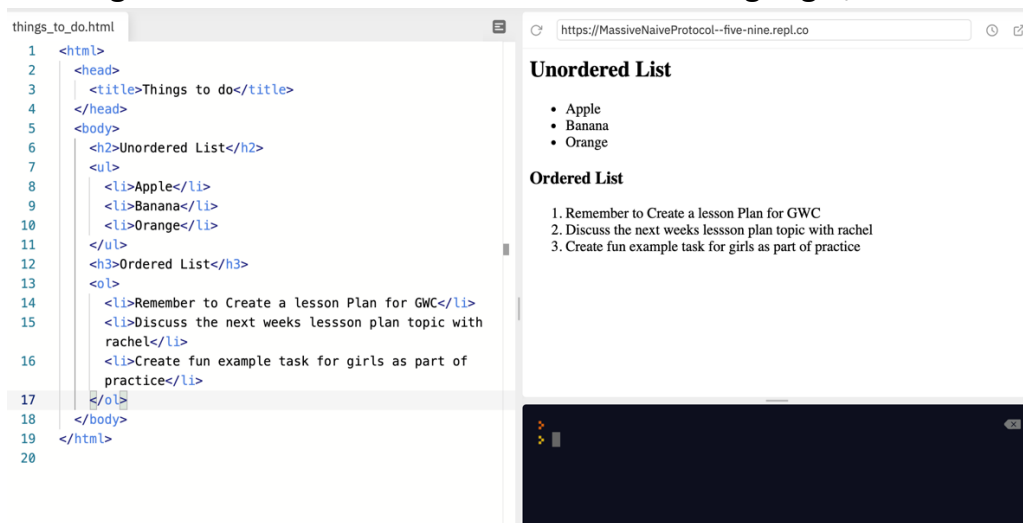


Figure 2: Ordered List

Description List:

A Description List is used to describe each item in the list. It begins with a `<dl>` tag and ends with a closing tag `</dl>`.

- Within the `<dl>` tag we use `<dt>` tag that defines the name of the items, example: `<dt> Coffee </dt>`, and to have a description for the item we use `<dd>` tag.

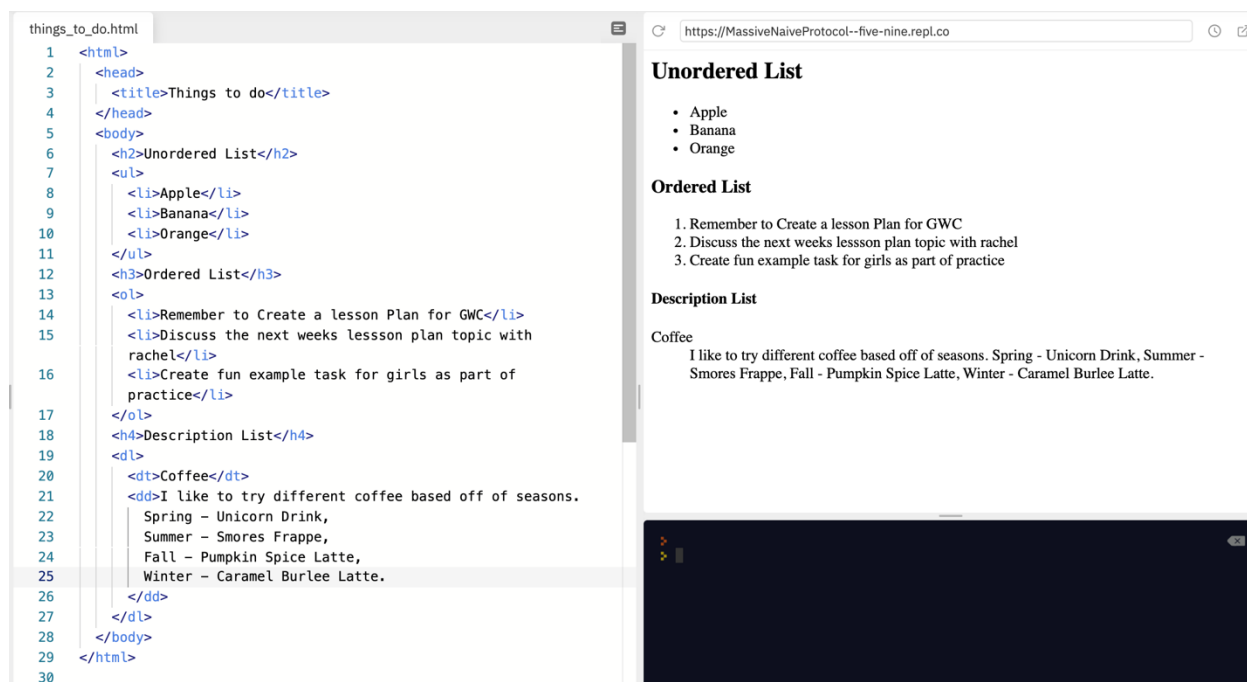


Figure 3: Description List
